DRUMSHANBO GUNPOWDER

The combination of lemon, lime, and grapefruit is subtle. The gunpowder is heavy enough to mellow out any astringent flavor and give you a nice front, and back end profile.

GLEN DALOUGH SPRING

The Spring gin is a fresh mix of young green shoots, wild botanical leaves and flowers. With each taste, this gin transports you to a place and time in our home - the Wicklow Mountains.

GLEN DALOUGH AUTUMN

Autumn is packed with wild fruits and berries, it's the bounty of the surrounding mountains bottled.

GLEN DALOUGH WILD BOTANICAL

Following on from Glendalough's range of seasonal botanical gins, this is the all-year-round release. Made with locally foraged botanicals, this is floral with notes of autumn fruits and winter spices.

GLEN DALOUGH WINTER

The gin is produced using some botanicals foraged from the nearby County Wicklow mountains, these include bog myrtle, fennel, juniper and hawthorn.

GLEN DALOUGH ROSE

This small batch gin is comprised of their Wild Botanical gin and a selection of different rose petals, including Wild Rose, Heritage Rose & Damask Rose.
